Charity Objects


- Support the NHS and RJAH – provide grants to the Trust and partner organisations to enhance services and facilities, focusing on orthopaedic care.

Charity Vision


Our vision is for every patient, family and staff member at RJAH to experience outstanding care supported by exceptional facilities, innovation and compassion.
